

Celgene Patient Assistance Program Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to participate for the Celgene PAP, uninsured or underinsured patients must meet the following PAP eligibility criteria:

1. Annual family gross income (before taxes and deductions) must be equal to or less than 650% of the current Federal Poverty Level **or**
2. If the patient's out-of-pocket (OOP) prescription spend for the current calendar year totals 3% or more of the total family gross income.

Patient must provide gross household income documentation. Annual family gross income represents the combined income of all household members.

The patient must provide their most recent federal income tax return, verifying financial status for the total family household. If a federal income tax return is not available, the patient must provide at least one of the following:

- Social Security award letter for current calendar year
- Unemployment letter
- W-2 or 1099 forms
- Last three (3) consecutive paycheck stubs
- Pension Statement

If the patient's OOP prescription spend for the current calendar year totals 3% or more of the total family gross income, the patient must provide one of the following:

- Pharmacy report documenting patient's annual OOP prescription expenses (must reflect current calendar year spend)
- EOB from insurer documenting total OOP met by patient for the current calendar year
